4th RACE – BREEDERS CUP FILLY & MARE SPRINT

Edgeway jock seemed hesitant on this filly wanting the lead, but she did so with little effort up the backstretch. She was headed to her inside around the turn, but put that rival away a few strides entering the stretch and kept going under Bravo.

Estilo Talentoso received a three-wide tracking trip under J. Ortiz and had clear sailing entering the stretch. She was in the three path of a four horse duel once they hit the 1/8th pole where she kept going, but she couldn't pass the eventual winner to her outside and was caught on the wire to miss the runner-up spot.

Ce Ce had no problems here as she sat in mid-pack of this five horse field behind a pair of dueling frontrunners. She took charge entering the stretch and always looked like the winner under confident handling by Espinoza.

5th RACE – BREEDERS TURF SPRINT

Glass Slippers (GB) won this race last year after just missing the Prix de l'Abbaye on the Arc card. She exits the 2021 edition of the race, but was all out to get 3rd and seemed to lack the same kick that she showed last year.

Emaraaty Ana (GB) tracked a fast pacesetter in the Betfair Sprint Cup, assumed command at about the halfway mark and then was all out to last to the wire in a very game (and likely taxing) effort. However, he's had two months to recover from that upset win.

Lieutenant Dan won the Eddie D down the hillside course. He pressed the pace outside of Charmaine's Mia, opened up into the stretch and had more than enough to hold off the late-runners. He showed good speed on the DMR sprint course in August and the huge gelding may be up to the task.

Arrest Me Red had the best speed without having to be asked, opened up a bit into the turn, shrugged off a modest challenge on the turn and then turned away a more significant challenge at the top of the stretch, as he responded to two cracks of the whip to open back up. The soph is undefeated sprinting on the grass and hasn't needed the lead to win previously.

Golden Pal turned in a weird win in the Woodford at Keeneland as he broke on top and set the pace from the inside, but drifted out to the 3-path entering the turn and was tackled on the outside and from the rail as the field turned for home. He appeared about to be swamped when he suddenly changed gears in mid-stretch and powered away. That was the 3-yo's first win over older runners.

Case of You (Ire) appeared to be hopelessly bottled up in the Prix de l'Abbaye, but was angled out and found a seam with about 150 yards to go and changed gears when he saw daylight ran down Air de Valse, who had appeared home free. This was quite a finish over heavy going.

Gear Jockey dominated the \$1M Turf Sprint over the undulating Kentucky Downs layout. He broke sharply to track the pacesetter Bombard, drew even after 3F and kicked away as the field ran up the hill toward the finish line. He has made a successful transition to the short game over the last five or six months.

6th RACE – BREEDERS' CUP DIRT MILE

Restrainedvengeance was able to avoid early trouble when the horse inside of him (Tenfold) veered in at the break. The gelding was able to settle off the pace on the outside and Maldonado may have made the winning move early as he went for the lead between horses just before entering the far turn. He put the frontrunner away as they entered the stretch and just held off Tenfold for the win.

Snapper Sinclair broke sharply, but was allowed to settle near the back as they raced down the hill. He had clear sailing in the stretch under Rosario though he didn't change leads until nearing the wire. He set the pace in his last route start so was this a training tactic to help him settle early next time he tries a route?

7th RACE – BREEDERS' CUP FILLY & MARE TURF

Rourgir (FR) accelerated nicely and just got up at the wire over a very game Grand Glory. The Prix De L'Opera has been a very key B.C. race as last year's winner (Tanawa) won the B.C. Turf and the 3rd-place finisher (Audarya) won the Filly & Mare turf. In 2017 at Del Mar, the 1-2 finishers in this race ran 1-2 in the Filly & Mar Turf just switching places

War Like Goddess made it four straight Graded Stakes wins in the Flower Bowl at Saratoga. She sat 3rd of six in a strung out field for the first half of the race. The field started to bunch as they went into the far turn, but she was still 3rd coming off the turn before a strong burst at the top of the stretch took her to the lead and she won comfortably. She was flattered when My Sister Nat, who rallied for 3rd, came back to win a Grade III as a heavy favorite Oct 3.

Audarya (FR) won the F&M Turf last year after running 3rd in this race. This year she pressed the pace from the inside on a heavy, demanding course, and the outside may have been the place to be this day. She took the lead in the stretch, but was headed about 100 yards from the wire by a trio of outside closers, including winner Rourgir. Still, a 4th-place finish under the circumstances was pretty solid and she has a chance to defend her title.

Teona (IRE) has run very well on firmer turf courses and has struggled on soft turf. She was being pointed to the Arc D'Triomphe after her second straight win in the Group I Prix Vermeille, but was pulled from consideration when the connections saw that the race would be contested on heavy footing. She may enjoy the firmer turf she'll get at Del Mar.

Pocket Square (GB) was in no hurry from the gate in this 5-horse Grade III at Belmont racing in the clear on the outside down the backstretch. She moved up on her own on the far turn and got a tap by the jock entering the stretch and accelerated nicely to the lead. She got a couple of raps with the whip midstretch, but was wrapped up late winning easily. She was 2/5 odds and didn't beat much, but has to be respected as Chad Brown has won this race 4 times in the last 9 runnings, the last time in 2018.

8th RACE – BREEDERS' CUP SPRINT

Dr. Schivel pressed the pace from the rail early when he steadied slightly and this may have been when Prat lost the right rein. The soph then took over the lead entering the far turn with Prat able to keep him along the rail around the turn in a fine show of horsemanship. The "Dr." then drew off in the stretch in a handy win.

9th RACE – BREEDERS' CUP MILE

Mo Forza won his last two starts in 2020 and won the same two races this year with Smooth Like Strait and Hit The Road running 2-3 in both. He probably got the best trip of the 3 Mile entrants in this 5-horse race. He relaxed early as the other 4 contested for the early lead from the gate and Hit The Road got pinched and had to be taken back on the first turn and ended up last on the backstretch. Forza still bided his time while Smooth Like Strait got strong pressure on the front by a longshot all the way to the top of the stretch. Strait proved game late, but the early pressure may have taken its toll as Forza was able to run him down and win by a half. Hit The Road got a very strange ride, but did rally to be a head behind Strait.

In Love (BRZ) won his third straight and first Gr 1 in this Kee race. He broke sharply from the 3-hole, but was content to drop back about 5 lengths on the rail around the turn and thru the backstretch. With no room inside, the jock began to search for space outside and finally got an opening mid-stretch and accelerated strongly to pass a group of horses and win going away. The 2-3 finishers (Tell Your Daddy and Somelikeithotbrown) were 3-4 on the waiting list for this B.C. race.

Space Blues (IRE) raced 7 furlongs on very heavy (bog-like) turf. He broke well but was outrun early and near the back of the pack taking a lot of kickback in this big field. He was moved outside coming off the right-hand turn and absolutely exploded the final two furlongs to win going away, reportedly coming home a full second faster the next best closing 2-furlongs by the filly Pearls Galore. The outside seems the place to be when the turf is really soft, but his finish was still pretty impressive.

Pearls Galore (FR) a filly facing the boys, was prominent from the start in this 7F Group I on very heavy turf. She raced between two other pacesetters and the three were still that way turning for home. She looked like she might get inhaled midstretch, but she just kept finding more. She was no match late for the 'rocketship' Space Blues, but was very game holding off another runner at the wire to grab 2nd.

RACE APPRAISAL

ANALYSIS: Welcome to Breeders' Cup 2021 and just the second here at Del Mar. Remember to dress in layers if you are actually attending and arriving when the gates open at 8:00 AM. The Digest's Fractional Charting puts **Appreciated**, **Kazan (Ire)**, and **Red Hornet** on top, but all three are suspect. The top two saw their marks jump sharply when they ran 1-2 in a slow-early, five-horse \$40,000 claimer Oct 24. Can they repeat that in this larger field? We're betting that they can't even though both have won at Del Mar. **Red Hornet** earned good numbers without threatening in a string of Midwest Stakes this summer, but was no threat to this kind at Keeneland last time and his numbers dipped. Instead, we'll focus **Via**

Egnatia, **Dacey Mo Chara (GB)**, and **Offlee Naughty**. **Via Egnatia** has Lone 'F' potential and is stretched back out after beating softer in his first two starts on the comeback trail. **Dacey Mo Chara (GB)** gets a switch to Prat after finishing in the money with this kind in his first two starts as a winner. **Offlee Naughty** became one of five next-out winners from an Aug 21 Maiden heat when she won at Del Mar Oct 3. She was 6/1 in both races and may offer similar odds. She's the upset threat.
CLOSERS: Fastest in the stretch in recent races at or near this distance have been: **Offlee Naughty** :27.4 - **Spirit Maker** :28.0 - **One Fast Bro** :28.4

HORSE COMMENTS

One Fast Bro earned a big number beating Cal-breds here in his July 31 return to action, but his Final Time Ratings have reverted to the mean in two subsequent starts. That said, he was runner-up under these conditions in both, has won on this oval and the 1-2 finishers in the paper race are likely spotted too high. Interestingly, the two one-hole winners at this trip in nine-horse fields (over the last five years) both went wire-to-wire. That's not his style.

Kazan (IRE) sat in the middle of a five-horse field Oct 24 and finished steadily to be lapped on **Appreciated** (below). That five horse field produced improved marks for the top two, but such five-horse fields, especially those with slow paces, can produce inflated final figures. On the plus side, he has won three times on this layout.

Offlee Naughty rallied from last to win a six-horse Maiden event Oct 3, making him the 5th horse from 5th Race on Aug 21 to win their next start. He may be very underrated on paper.

Red Hornet won his debut in Chicago and then nibbled in three subsequent soph Stakes. He rallied way too late at Keeneland and his number really dropped off. He does well on paper based on his Aug 7 run at Ellis Park.

Appreciated made it back-to-back wins after being claimed by Jeff Mullins when he controlled a slow pace and held **Kazan (Ire)** safe to the wire

Oct 24. Doug O'Neill claimed him and protects him under the Allowance conditions. We plotted that Oct 24 win, but his previous races suggest that it's probably 12 points or four lengths too fast. He's previously been a 'pack horse' in the Allowance ranks. He's a contender, but is hardly unbeatable.

Dacey Mo Chara (GB) gets a switch to Powell's favorite rider (and fellow countrymen) Prat after finishing in-the-money with this kind in his first two starts as a winner. He won here in July and seems well spotted again. He gives Powell (**Kazan (Ire)**) a second starter.

Via Egnatia is a 7-yr that is shooting for the hat trick after registering two wins over slightly softer claimers to begin his current campaign. Victor Espinoza strings along and this one has won twice on this course. He set the pace in his Sept 3 route win and returned to win sprinting Oct 15. He may be able to control the pace again.

Jack Sprout regressed on dirt Oct 23, but his Aug 27 comeback win over \$32,000 NW2 types gives him a look and both of his wins have come on this layout.

Spirit Maker won his 2020 U.S. debut in New York and then didn't run again for 7-½ months. He rallied to split the field here July 17 and then raced closer to the pace before weakening Oct 10. Perhaps he's getting fit now.

RACE APPRAISAL

ANALYSIS: On paper it looks like this could come down to a top 4yo filly vs. a top 3yo filly in **Princess Grace** and **Going Global**. **Grace** is 6-for-7 and has won all three of her Graded Stakes this year, including the Grade II Yellow Ribbon on this course Aug 7. She's clearly the one to beat and we liked that she was able to overcome a slow break and rally from farther off the pace than usual to win a Grade III in Kentucky Sept 11. She seems deserving of the HF 15. **Going Global** is 5-for-6 since coming to the U.S. in February. Her only loss was a 2nd in a 3yo Grade II here July 24, but she rebounded to win a 3yo Grade I here Aug 21. It's worth noting her Final Time Ratings were in the high130 range prior to earning a whopper 149 FTR in that last win. It could be she's just now reaching her peak, but we also might try to beat her in her first try vs. older. Those looking for

better gambling odds than you'll get on the big two should give **Zofelle** or **Warren's Showtime** a look. **Zofelle** has been freshened since faltering in a Grade I on 'good' turf at Belmont June 5. She ran well in her other three Graded Stakes on 'firm' turf this year with a win and lapped on the winner at the wire in the other two. We'll make her the alternative HF 15a value play. At first glance, **Warren's Showtime** looks a cut below as she's done most of her damage in Cal-bred Stakes, but she's actually finished in the money in all three of her Graded Stakes this year, including winning a Grade III June 20. She fires every time out and seems to have a 'competitive edge' to her. We'll make her the HF 20.
CLOSERS: Fastest in the stretch in recent races at or near this distance have been: Zofelle :21.8 - Going Global :22.0 - Constantia :23.3

HORSE COMMENTS

Zofelle (IRE) ran well in three straight Graded Stakes on 'firm' turf before faltering on 'good' in a Grade I at Belmont June 5. She's worked eight times since Aug 29 and could be a threat returning to a 'firm' surface.

Princess Grace is 6-for-7 and has won all three of her Graded Stakes this year, including the Grade II Yellow Ribbon on this course Aug 7. She came from father off the pace than usual in her Grade III win at KD Sept 11, but that just showed versatility. She's probably the one to beat.

Abscond just missed in Graded Stakes on 'firm' at Woodbine July 27 and KD Sept 11, a race won by Princess Galore, before a midpack effort in a Grade I at KEE on 'good' Oct 9. She hasn't won since 2019, but probably deserves exotics consideration.

Glesga Gal (IRE) has done her winning on synthetic overseas (2-for-3), but is 0-for-8 on turf. She did just miss in a small-field Stake Oct 2, but was 5th in her only Group III Sept 8. We're looking at others.

Ippodamia's Girl won a restricted Stake here July 17, but has run poorly in her last two starts with softer than this. Class seems a cloud.

Bodhicitta (GB) is 0-for-3 this year, but hit the board in all three. She was 4th behind Princess Grace in a Grade II Aug 7, a race she won last year, and 3rd in a Grade II Sept 4, both on this course. We'll have to look elsewhere for a winner.

Going Global (IRE) is a 3yo that shipped to the U.S. at the beginning of the year and has won 5-of-6 3yo Stakes. She was upset in a Grade II here July 24, but rebounded with a nice win in a Grade I over the course Aug 21. She faces older for the first time, but charts well and has to be respected.

Warren's Showtime won a Cal-bred sprint Stake Oct 16 and did win a Grade III at a mile June 20. She seems a cut below the best in here, but she's sharp and that Grade III win three back would have put her near the top in the charting had we plotted it.

Constantia has only sprinted this year and finished 5th in back-to-back softer Stakes here July 25 and at KD Sept 11. She'd be a surprise.

RACE APPRAISAL

ANALYSIS: This race is being contested for just the 14th time and it's produced a near-normal rate of four winning favorites (just a bit over 30%). However, the average winning price is \$24 and the median price is \$16 and this overflow field (they could have easily split this race) is unlikely to reduce those historical payouts by much if at all. **Golden Pal** is the 7/2 Morning Line favorite for Wesley Ward who has also entered **Arrest Me Red** and **Kimari**, a comebacking filly. Surprisingly, given his vast array of turf sprinters, he's never won this race. **Pal** and **Red** are both sharp sophs. **Pal** caused himself some problems and still won Oct 9 while **Red** made the running when best Oct 2, but is capable of coming from off the pace. Both of them are 4-for-4 sprinting on the grass in the U.S. **Red** offers more value (and an HF 20), though stablemate **Kimari** has value potential, too. The Ward 3-yos are sandwiched around the primary California contender, **Lieutenant Dan**. He is 3-for-3 sprinting on the grass since coming back to the races this summer, including a good on-the-pace

win over this layout in August. He seems quick enough to get position. **Fast Boat** and **Gear Jockey** have traded decisions in their last two starts. **Fast Boat** had first run after **Jockey** broke slowly Aug 6, but **Jockey** was flying late that day. They met up again in the Turf Sprint at Kentucky Downs, a race carrying \$1,000,000 purse, and **Jockey** broke much better, set up outside of the speedy **Bombard** and drew off the last three furlongs. It was an impressive win from a horse that had previous been a middle distance turfer. He's drawn nicely outside gets the HF 15. **Boat** gets the second HF 20 and it's noted that post 11 has been the most productive when 12 go on this layout. **Boat** had a rough trip from the inside last time and should fare better here. **CLOSERS:** Fastest in the stretch in recent races at or near this distance have been: Glass Slippers (GB) :10.5 - Fast Boat and Hollywood Talent :10.6 - Commander (Fr) :10.7 - Arrest Me Red :11.0

Glass Slippers (GB) is back to defend his title, but seemed in a little better form in 2021 and is unlucky to get the rail in this full field. He's the only horse to come over from Europe to win this race.

Emaraaty Ana (GB) became a Group 1 winner as a 5-yo when he pressed the pace and held on to win at Haydock Sept 4. He was all out late, but has had two months to recover and he may have enough speed to get position from the inside.

Golden Pal is a perfect 4-for-4 sprinting on the grass in the U.S., most recently going wire-to-wire to beat older runners for the first time at Keeneland Oct 9, a race in which he won despite drifting out into the turn. He chased neighbor **Ana** home when sent to England Aug 20, but likes it better over here.

Lieutenant Dan is a huge 5-yo gelding that has found a new lease on life as a turf sprinter. He's 3-for-3 sprinting on the grass, most recently winning on the hillside course at Santa Anita. He showed good speed from the inside here when best in the Green Flash Aug 22 and he figures 'right there'. He's a contender.

Arrest Me Red gives Wesley Ward (Golden Pal) a second sharp 3-yo. This one is 2-for-2 since Ward took over his training and can set or track the pace as required. He's perfect sprinting on the grass, too.

A Case of You (IRE) has been sent over after staging an improbable win in the Group 1 Prix de l'Abbaye Oct 3, a race in which he found a seam and staged a furious rally to get up in the final strides. He left Glass Slippers (above) in his wake and will be out to be just the second import to win this race.

Charmaine's Mia set a pressured pace in the Eddie D Oct 1 and the 5-yo mare faded late. She figures to be out winging again, but may get swallowed up when the real running starts.

Caravel has not improved in two starts since Bobby Flay bought into him and Graham Motion took over training. He threw in a stinker in the Turf Monster at Parx Sept 25, but was Grade 1 placed in Canada prior to that and doesn't figure too far back.

Kimari is a 4-yo filly and Wesley Ward's third entrant. She's been off since winning the Grade 1 Madison on dirt at Keeneland April 3 and it's interesting that he skips the Filly & Mare Sprint to run here. She has won on the grass and has been training steadily. She deserves odds-beating consideration.

Gear Jockey got a career change when he was shortened up this summer. He responded by winning a Classified Allowance July 17. He broke slowly, but finished fast when 3rd behind Fast Boat in the Grade 3 Troy Stakes there Aug 5 and then scored a major coup in the Turf Sprint at Kentucky Downs Sept 11, as he broke well to track the pacesetter and took over at the halfway mark. He cleared off nicely and won the \$1M sprint like an improving horse.

Fast Boat got first run while wide throughout in the Troy Stakes and finished with good energy to win that Saratoga affair Aug 5. He drew inside and didn't seem comfortable in the Turf Sprint at Kentucky Downs Sept 11 and lacked the same rally. He's back on the outside and the 11-hole has been the most productive post (since 2016) when 12 go at this distance and the rails are down (3 wins from 10 races). He's 12/1 on the line and has to be viewed as an upset threat.

10th RACE – BREEDERS' CUP DISTAFF

As Time Goes By sat in the garden spot while out in the clear and made her run around the far turn, but could only chase Private Mission and never was able to get close to the winner. She was dominated by a couple of others in here in her two prior starts.

Private Mission tracked the pacesetter from the 2-path, took over on the far turn without having to be asked and easily held off favored As Time Goes By as the stretch was a no-passing zone. She's 2-for-2 around two turns and tracked the pace in both. That style should play well in this lineup.

Royal Flag relaxed behind slow fractions, moved up around the turn to loop the chasers and drew even with the pacesetter Horologist at the top of the stretch. Royal Flag was out in the middle of the track and she never missed a beat and drew off as the odds-on winner. She was the only horse finishing in this one.

Dunbar Road did her thing in the Spinster, too, as she lagged Letruska early and made a wide rally into and through the stretch. She ended up 2nd, but this is a deeper field.

Horologist won the Beldame in 2020 and controlled the pace for the most part, but had no response when Royal Flag rallied widest of all.

Letruska did her thing as she broke on top, went right to the front, and didn't miss a beat to the wire. Her only recent loss came when Shedaresthedevil beat her out of the gate in the Azeri back in April.

Shedaresthedevil broke sharply from the outside box, just as she had done when best in the Azeri this spring. She went right to the front, set all the pace and was dead game to the finish despite being tackled on both sides turning for home. It was a game effort under a strong handling.

Malathaat was sent off as the heavy favorite and got the job done in the Alabama, as she lagged early and then responded when asked to run approaching the turn. She came widest of all into the stretch and drew off under a strong ride.

Clairiere had been troubled early and took a ton of dirt in the Alabama, but was flying at Royal Flag at the end. She returned five weeks later in the Cotillion and raced wide throughout while settling nicely under a loose rein. She picked it up after 5F and began to reel in the five horses in front of here. She was widest of all as the field lined up for home and she once again powered home in good style.

11th RACE – BREEDERS' CUP TURF

Tarnawa (IRE) is a super filly that won this race over the boys last year at KEE. She looks set to defend her title off a near miss in the Group Prix de L'Arc de Triomphe, a race run over very soft footing because of rain. She raced along the rail in midpack down the long straightaway and was still there surrounded by horses around the right turn and into the stretch and had to wait, wait, wait for a hole to open which she found on the rail with 300 meters to go. She finished strongly inside, but had to settle for 2nd behind a huge longshot that got up on the outside. The outside is usually better in rainy conditions, so Tarnawa ran a 'monster' of a race and reportedly needed a couple of weeks to fully recover from the ordeal.

Domestic Spending (GB) won both of his Grade I races this year prior to this Arlington Gr 1. He broke from the 3-hole and sat in fourth in the clear in a strung-out field behind a slow pace. The eventual upset winner kind of 'stole' the race on the lead as he had plenty left turning for home and burst clear. 'Spending rallied well and cut in to the lead, but had to settle for 2nd

Rockemperor (IRE) broke in a line, but was allowed to fall back to next to last behind a lively early pace. The field began to bunch up a bit heading into the far turn with Rockemperor still next to last on the hedge and Gufo last moving outside. Gufo made a solid outside move, while 'emperor was stuck behind horses and had to steady to last, but he swung outside and actually got nose-to-nose with Gufo when they straightened out in the stretch. 'Emperor continued that solid move and drew off to a daylight win, while Gufo flattened out and settled for 3rd. It's possible given the race shape that Gufo moved too soon and 'Emperor benefitted from having to wait on the turn.

Astronaut is lightly raced, but seems to be thriving since moving to marathon distances. He ran 2nd to Acclimate when jock lost the whip in a Grade III June 19, but got revenge today. He broke from the 10-hole right into the far turn and was understandable outside sitting mid-pack. He pretty much stayed that way the first time around while Acclimate set the pace throughout. He started moving up outside mid-turn and was part of a wall of horses chasing Acclimate at the top of the stretch. He accelerated the best to get the win over another longshot, while Acclimate settled for a game 3rd. None of the low odds horses were a factor, but Astronaut might be an improving 4yo and a win over the course is a plus.

12th RACE – BREEDERS' CUP CLASSIC

Max Player made it two consecutive 1-1/4 Mile dirt wins in the Jockey Club Gold Cup as he broke well to track the pacesetter favorite Forza Di Oro to the stretch and then changed gears when he changed leads and drew away to an easy win. The early fractions were slow enough that the chasers didn't have much chance. That seems unlikely in the Classic.

Knicks Go slipped down to Churchill for the Lukas Classic and won what was essentially a workout. He set easy fractions for a half-mile, began to move after 5F and slowly increased his advantage to the wire while appearing to look around (not a first for him). He remains very sharp.

Essential Quality tracked the pacesetter Midnight Bourbon through a slow first six furlongs in the Travers, moved closer on the far turn and drew alongside as Bourbon hit the stretch. He had good outside position on his rival and slowly edged away from his game rival. This one's numbers are rarely flashy, but he finds a way to win.

Hot Rod Charlie changed tactics in the Pa Derby and went right to the front. He was pressured throughout by Midnight Bourbon, the horse that he had stalked and caused to fall in the Haskell July 17. The two of them drew away from the overmatched field around the far turn and Charlie went wide and caused Bourbon problems entering the stretch. He kicked away from his rival, but it seems like this horse is capable of winning and also causing himself and his backers headaches.

Tripoli was wide throughout and was asked to run a bit on the backstretch before being really asked to run on the far turn. He was able to loom up while three or four wide into the stretch and flattened out through the lane. He won the Pacific Classic when able to stalk the pace, but is hooking lots of speed in the BC Classic.

Art Collector controlled the pace with a string of 24 flat quarter miles and that left him with plenty left to hold off favored Maxfield, who had tracked him from the bell. He's now won three straight and he won 4 in a row in 2020. He was able to track the pace in one of his 2020 route wins and on the bullring to Charles Town prior to this..

Medina Spirit didn't break on top, but was immediately sent to the fore and had the lead when he hit the first turn. He set the pace under a bit of pressure, kicked away a bit into the far turn and then coasted around the turn and allowed the field to get closer. He switched leads and accelerated away through the stretch. He had a 50/1 outsider chase him throughout and the others didn't really fire. He looked good just the same.

RACE APPRAISAL

ANALYSIS: War Like Goddess has been the top turf filly in the U.S. having won 6-of-7 and four straight Graded Stakes this year, including a Grade I at this distance Sept 4 at Saratoga. The competition might not have been the greatest, but she's won impressively and tops the charting. The top West Coast hope looks like Going To Vegas, who has won three straight, including wiring a Grade I at SA Oct 2. Again, the competition can be questioned, but she charts well and is probably the one they have to catch turning for home. This race is loaded with dangerous imports, including last year's upset winner Audarya. Her form this year hasn't been as good, but she ran a similar race in the same final prep as last year when 4th in a Group I in France behind Rougir Oct 3. She might move up on the firmer U.S. turf and can't be ruled out. Rougir, who won the Group I Prix De L'Opera Oct 3 that produced two B.C. winners last year, looks like a big-time threat off her French form except for one little knock. She

struggled both times she raced on 'firm' in France and Euro 'firm' is usually softer than U.S. 'firm'. Love is unproven on 'firm', but beat Audarya winning a Group I June 16 in England and has finished in the money in her last three Group Stakes. She certainly has the credentials. Loves Only You has run very well in top Graded Stakes in Japan, Hong Kong and Dubai this year. We worry about 'jet lag' and a Japanese jockey unfamiliar with U.S. racing, but she's been freshened since Aug 22 and is a threat if she fires. In the end, Goddess might be the one to beat, but she likely won't offer any value (7/2ML), so we'll gamble the HF 15a on Rougir and hope she handles the firm footing today. Our HF 20 is Going To Vegas, who might have a chance to pull off the wire-to-wire upset. **CLOSERS:** Fastest in the stretch in recent races at or near this distance have been: Pocket Square :33.0 - My Sister Nat :34.2 - War Like Goddess :34.6

HORSE COMMENTS

Going to Vegas has won her last three starts, including a Grade II here Sept 4 and a Grade I at SA Oct 2. She's mainly raced at shorter distances, but just missed in a Grade III at this trip here last November. She charts well and might be the one to catch turning for home.

Pocket Square (GB) won her last two starts at 9F, a high-line Allowance at SAR Aug 25 and a Grade III on 'good' at BEL Sept 25. She looks a cut below the top ones in here, but is sharp and we love the connections.

Acanella (GB) won a Group III at 9F Aug 27, but was midpack in a Group I mile Sept 11, both in Ireland. Her best win came in her longer race to date in that Aug 27 affair, so maybe she'll enjoy today's longer going. On paper, though, others look better.

Rougir (FR) has been 'right there' in four straight Group Stakes in France and won the Group I Prix De L'Opera Oct 3, the same race Tamawa won before beating the boys in the B.C. Turf last year. The only knock we see is she didn't run well both times she raced on 'firm' turf in France.

Queen Supreme (IRE) was racing in South Africa before running last at big odds in a Grade II in England Sept 24. Pass.

Love (IRE) was 3-for-3 in Group I Stakes as a 3yo last year in England. She won a Group I in her 4yo debut June 16, beating defending champ Audarya, but has settled for minor awards in her last three Group Stakes, most recently losing by a nose in a Group II in Ireland Sept 12. She's unproven on 'firm', but looks like a solid threat.

War Like Goddess has been impressive in four straight wins vs. Graded Stakes company, most recently easily winning a Grade I at this distance

Sept 4 at Saratoga. We might question the competition in those races, but she tops the charting and doesn't appear to have any knocks.

Loves Only You (JPN) is a world traveler as she just missed in a Grade I in Dubai March 27, won a Grade I in Hong Kong April 25 and returned to Japan where she just missed in a Grade II Aug 22. She handled 'firm' in Japan and could be a major player if she doesn't suffer from jet-lag.

My Sister Nat (FR) finished in the money behind War Like Goddess in Gr Stakes at Saratoga Aug 7 and Sept 4, but won a Grade III as the big favorite at Belmont Oct 3. She ran to long odds (9th) in this race last year off similar form, so we'd limit her to minor award consideration

Ocean Road (IRE) won a minor Allowance Dec 2, but is 0-for-3 this year as 3yo, most recently when 3rd in a Group III Oct 8. Others have better credentials.

Dogtag has finished in the money in three straight Graded Stakes, a 2nd to Princess Grace (the favorite in the Gr II 3rd race today) and a 2nd and 3rd in her last two behind Going To Vegas. She's not terrible, but it would be a major upset if she won today.

Audarya (FR) pulled off the 17/1 upset in this race last year at KEE when it was run at 9.5F and she raced on Lasix. She's 0-for-4 this year in France, but just missed in a Group I Aug 22 before running 4th in a Group I behind Rougir Oct 3. Her form this year doesn't seem as good, but she ran about the same in the Prix De L'Opera as last year and maybe she's just better on the firmer footing she'll get in the U.S.

RACE APPRAISAL

ANALYSIS: Last year's B.C. Mile produced a 70/1 bomb, but we don't think we'll see fireworks like that this year because we expect the betting might be pretty evenly spread in this big field. Finishing speed is often key in mile races at Dmr, and it's hard not to be impressed with the way **Space Blues** flew home in a Gr I going 7F in France Oct 3. He's a closer that will have to avoid trouble and that French race has produced a few beaten favorites in this race in recent years, but **Blues** has won 7 of his last 9 and won the last two times he's run on 'firm' turf. His barn is a ridiculous 6-for-14 on the year and we'll make him the HF 15a. The filly **Pearls Galore** couldn't hold off **Blues** in that Gr I sprint Oct 3, but was a solid 2nd. She's been 1st or 2nd in four straight vs. top company overseas, including a near miss at a mile in a Gr I vs. her own gender Sept 11. She may have some 'value appeal' if you don't like the short price on **Blues**. **In Love** has won

three straight and showed a good style for this course winning a Gr I at KEE from off the pace Oct 9. He could definitely be a threat. **Mo Forza**, **Smooth Like Strait** and **Hit The Road** have run 1-2-3 in two straight Grade II's in So Cal. **Forza**, who has a strong record at Del Mar, is on a 4-race win streak and must be respected. He did get a perfect set-up in his last start as **Strait** got into an early duel with a longshot and **Hit The Road** actually ran very well after a very strange/bad ride. **Strait**, who also likes DMR, will probably have to deal with dedicated frontrunner **Blowout** and that could leave him vulnerable late. **Hit The Road** has a couple of wins at DMR and gets a rider switch to Velazquez. We'll make him our HF 20. **CLOSERS:** Fastest in the stretch in recent races at or near this distance have been: Smooth Like Strait :22.2 - In Love :23.0 - Hit The Road :23.4

HORSE COMMENTS

Master of The Seas (IRE) won a Group III April 15 and just missed in a Grade I, both for 3yos, but has gone backwards in two Group Stakes vs. older since. He might be the barns 'second string' behind Space Blues.

Smooth Like Strait has finished 2nd in two straight Grade II's behind Mo Forza, but was actually very game after dueling on a wicked pace Oct 2. Speed hasn't been great going a mile at Dmr and he may have to deal with dedicated front-runner Blowout.

Space Blues (IRE) has been impressive winning his last two starts closing at 7F overseas, a Gr 2 in England Aug 21 and a Gr I in France Oct 3. The French race has produced winners of this race, but also a couple of beaten favorites. On the plus side, he's won his last two on 'firm'.

Raging Bull (FR) ran poorly in this race last year. He won a Gr I at KEE April 9, but has been just Ok in three starts since, including when 3rd in a Gr I at WO Sept 18. He's a barnmate of Blowout and would be a surprise.

Vin de Garde (JPN) ran 2nd in a Gr I in Dubai March 27, but his Japan form before and after that race wasn't great. We'll have to pass.

Mo Forza won his last two starts in 2020 and is 2-for-2 this year, all Grade II's at a mile and two of those were at DMR. He beat Smooth Like Strait and Hit The Road in both starts this year and has to be respected.

In Love (BRZ) has won three straight and proved he belongs in top company when he rallied to win a Grade I at KEE Oct 9. Two of those 3 wins were on less than 'firm', but he has the numbers to be a threat.

Hit the Road has finished 3rd behind Mo Forza and Smooth Like Strait in two straight Gr II's in So Cal and was 5th behind Raging Bull in a Gr I at KEE three back. He had a terrible trip/ride when finishing lapped on Forza Oct 2 which might have prompted a jock switch. Price play?.

Mother Earth (IRE) is a 3yo filly that rallied to run 2nd at a big price in the B.C. Juvenile Filly Turf last year at KEE. She won a Gr I in Ireland Aug 3 and was 2nd in a Gr I Oct 2, but finished midpack when tried against the boys in a Group I in England Oct 16. This seems a tough task.

Blowout (GB) is a frontrunning mare that beat her own gender in Gr Stakes May 1 and Oct 9, but ran 4th behind Got Stormy and Casa Creed when taking on the boys in a Gr I at Sar Aug 14. Chad Brown won this race at SA in 2019, but the front end is usually not the place to be at Dmr.

Got Stormy ran 5th in the B.C. Turf Sprint last year. She won a Gr I going a mile at Sar Aug 14, but was no factor in a Gr II sprint at KD Sept 11 and her '21 form is so-so. She does pop with a strong race now and again

Pearls Galore (FR) is a 4yo filly that just missed in a Gr I in Ire against her own sex Sept 11 and then was a more than credible 2nd to Space Blues in a Gr I against the boys in France Oct 3. She was a presser in Europe, but unproven on firm turf. She does have the talent to win.

Casa Creed finished far back at long odds in this race last year. He's probably done his best work sprinting as he won a Gr I sprint at Bel June 5 before a 3rd in a Gr I mile Aug 14 at Sar. He would be a surprise.

Ivar (BRZ) finished 4th in this race last year. He's only run twice this year finishing midpack in a Gr I going 9F at CD May 1 and 4th behind In Love in a Gr I mile at KEE on 'good' Oct 9. He came into last year's race off a Gr I win, so his modest recent form and poor post have us looking elsewhere.

Real Appeal (GER) is a first-time gelding that will need to scratch in. He's won two of his last three, including a Group II in Ireland Sept 11, so he comes in sharp. He also beat Pearls Galore winning a Gr III June 10.

Queen Supreme (IRE) ran last in a Group II in England after shipping from South Africa. She'll likely run in today's 7th race.

RACE APPRAISAL

ANALYSIS: Letruska and Shedaresthedevil meet in their 2021 rubber match. Shedaresthedevil handed Letruska her only loss of the year when she broke like a shot to take the track away from Letruska in the Azeri at Oaklawn Park March 13. Letruska was forced to take back a bit while caught between horses entering the stretch and ended up tracking her rival. She made a run at Shedaresthedevil turning for home, but couldn't get past her. They met again in New York in the Ogden O. Phipps June 5 and this time Letruska broke well from the inside and was able to get to the front put her rival away. Devil is capable of getting a flyer at the break as she demonstrated again in her last start and both runners are tough to pass. Run this race 100 times and Letruska is probably in front 85 times

and winning most of them. That's why she gets the HF 15. Shedaresthedevil can win if she makes it to the front first and she has been able to track the pace and win, as she did when she won here Aug 1. A win over the track is a bonus. The improving Private Mission may be able to get a dream trip drafting those two and is eligible to beat her odds should the likely 1-2 favorites go too fast too soon. Royal Flag, Malathaat, Dunbar Road, and Clairiere are the main off-pace threats. The last named filly is improving rapidly and will share longshot status with Private Mission. **CLOSERS:** Fastest in the stretch in recent races at or near this distance have been: Clairiere :35.7 - Royal Flag :36.0 - Dunbar Road :36.5

HORSE COMMENTS

Private Mission is perfect after two route starts and was able to track the pace before taking over. She seems quick enough to get position behind the speed as the horses on her immediate outside are not very fast. She's a contender with continued improvement.

Royal Flag is a 5-yr mare that has never been worse than 3rd in her 12-race career. She was lapped on Letruska (below) when 3rd Aug 28 and was a good 2nd to her when they met last year. There figures to be plenty of pace to set things up for her balanced attack. She's exotics material at the very least.

Malathaat is a soph filly whose only loss came when she wound up setting the pace in the 10 furlong Coaching Club of America Oaks July 24. She prefers to have a target and that won't be a problem in this lineup. She figures to be prominent through the stretch again.

Blue Stripe (ARG) is a South American import that has been away for six months. She won a couple of Graded Stakes to end her Argentinian career, but her slow works may not have her ready for this speedy group.

Clairiere was quickly gaining on Malathaat (above) when 2nd in the Alabama and returned to score a solid win when getting a clean trip from the outside in the Cotillion at Parx Sept 25. The improving soph has odds-beating potential and would be aided should a too fast pace develop.

Letruska was beaten out of the gate by Shedaresthedevil in her only loss of the year, the Azeri Stakes back on March 13. She's rattled off three

consecutive wire-to-wire wins at this 9F trip and is the one to catch if she breaks on top. She was forced to take back and track the pace in the Azeri and couldn't get past the pacesetter Devil. It could happen again depending upon the start.

Horologist adds speed to the race, but she was run down by Royal Flag Oct 10 and July 25 and is likely hooking too much other speed for her to last to the wire.

Shedaresthedevil can set the pace or stalk it and she tracked the leader when she shipped out her to win the five-horse Clement L. Hirsch Aug 1. She was game through the stretch when going wire-to-wire in the six-horse Locust Grove Sept 28 and she and Letruska have traded decisions in 2021.

As Time Goes By had no excuses when 2nd in the Zenyatta Oct 3 and was no match Letruska Aug 28 nor neighbor Devil Aug 1.

Marche Lorraine (JPN) has banked nearly \$2M with eight wins in Japan where the purses are uniformly huge. She has had two easy works over the track to acclimate, but has been off since Aug 12 and she may not have much impact.

Dunbar Road is winless in 2021, but has produced good runs into the stretch while chasing Letruska home in her last two starts. She was beaten by Royal Flag and Shedaresthedevil in her first two starts of the year, so she's 'exotics only' material.

RACE APPRAISAL

ANALYSIS: Euros have dominated this race recently aside from a Chad Brown winner at SA in 2019. Back to defend her title is the super filly (now mare) **Tarnawa**. She was 2nd in her last two starts overseas this year, but her effort in the Gr 1 Arc De Triumphe was sensational (check out our Video Notebook Page). Hopefully, she's fully recovered and is the one to beat, HF 15a style. **Domestic Spending** would seem the strongest of the Brown trio. He won four straight before a near miss in a Gr I at AP when not quite able to run down a lone 'F' tripper Aug 14. **Rockemperor** and the frontrunning **Tribhuvan** are barnmates of **Spending** that could make an impact at prices. **Broome** and **Japan** are longshots from the O'Brien

barn and he's won this race 4 times since 2010. We like **Japan** better as he just missed in a Gr I at Sar Aug 28 and may have 'bounced' in a Gr 1 at Bel Oct 9, his second U.S. start. He'll share HF 20 honors with **Astronaut**, who seems to be thriving since moving to a marathon distance, most recently turning the tables on **Acclimate** in a Gr II here Aug 21. Finally, **Yibir** is a 3yo that won a Gr II in ENG Aug 18 and easily won a million dollar 3yo Stake at Bel Sept 18. He fits on numbers and could still be on the upswing.

CLOSERS: Fastest in the stretch in recent races at or near this distance have been: Yibir :46.6 - Tarnawa, Walton Street :46.8 - Tribhuvan :46.9

HORSE COMMENTS

Rockemperor (IRE) had blinkers removed and pulled off an upset in a Gr 1 at Bel Oct 9, an effort that tops the charting. Brown, who also has Domestic Spending and Tribhuvan, won this race in 2019 at SA. He might have some longshot appeal.

United won a Gr II at SA Oct 2, the same race she won before running 8th in this race last year. She has a great record at DMR, but did run 4th in a Grade II behind Astronaut here Aug 21.

Domestic Spending (GB) is the shortest price of the Brown trio. She had won three straight Gr I's before a near miss in a Gr I at AP when she couldn't quite run down a loose on the lead frontrunner. She won her last Nov and looks like a major player.

Astronaut pulled off a huge upset in a Grade II here Aug 21. He may have to improve again, but seems to have found his game in marathons and could be worth a look at a price.

Tribhuvan (FR) won a Gr I at Mth, but faltered in a Gr I at Saratoga Aug 28. The frontrunner is the highest odds of the Brown trio, but fits on his good races, including a 2nd to barnmate Domestic Spending three back.

Acclimate is a frontrunner that faded in this race in 2019. He's been close in his last two lesser Gr Stakes, but would be a surprise.

Walton Street (GB) shipped from Dubai and a race in Germany and dominated a Gr I at WO when a heavy favorite Sept 18. He charts well, but we're skeptical of the competition he beat.

Broome (IRE) finished up the track in the Gr I Arc on heavy footing Oct 3, but was 2nd in a Gr II on firm Sept 12. He seems just a cut below, but O'Brien has won this race 4 times since 2010.

Sisfahan (FR) is a 3yo that has been running in Germany and lost his last two starts when facing older in Gr I's in September. Pass.

Yibir (GB) a 3yo, won a Gr II in ENG Aug 18 and then repeated in a million dollar 3yo Stake at Bel Sept 18. He's sharp and charts well, so maybe he isn't overmatched.

Gufo won a Gr I at Sar Aug 28 and was 3rd in a Gr I behind Rockemperor at BEL Oct 9. He could be a factor, but Domestic Spending has beaten him three times in his last 8 starts.

Teona (IRE) is a 3yo filly that beat older mares in a Gr I in France Sept 12. That was on firm footing, too. Taking on the best older males does seem a challenging task.

Tarnawa (IRE) is a 5yo mare that won this race last year in her only U.S. start. She's finished 2nd in her last two Gr I's overseas, but her near miss in the Arc De Triumphe Oct 3 was very impressive (see Video Notebook PG). She's the one to beat.

Japan (GB) just missed to Gufo in a Gr I in his U.S. debut Aug 28 at SAR. He may have 'bounced' in a Gr I at Bel Oct 9 and could rebound at price for a barn that has won this race 4 times since 2010.

Bolshoi Ballet (IRE) is a 3yo, the first AE and least likely of the O'Brien entrants after running 4th in two straight 3yo Stakes.

Channel Maker finished 3rd in this race last year, but was in better form there. The 7yo has been no factor in his last three Gr Stakes this year.

Mogul (GB) is another O'Brien that ran 5th in this race last year. He has struggled in his last two Gr Stakes in ENG and FRA this year. Pass.

Friar's Road stepped up in class and ran 3rd behind two of these in a Gr II Oct 2 at SA. He likes the move to turf, but likely won't run here.

RACE APPRAISAL

ANALYSIS: We began the day suggesting that the Fractional Charting should be taken with a grain of salt. We'll end the long Breeders' Cup day (gates opened at 8:00 AM and this race is slated to go at 5:40 or just 13 minutes before the sun sets behind the grandstand. **Knicks Go** is a 5-yr that has only lost twice since being sent to Brad Cox for his 4-yr season. One loss came in Saudi Arabia Feb 20 and the second came in the Met Mile June 5, a race that is contested around one turn. He's since been unbeatable around two turns and it's noted that this race was run in frontrunning fashion here in 2017. **Knicks Go** has the best two-turn speed and is the one to beat. **Medina Spirit** and **Hot Rod Charlie** are the two horses that seem capable of forcing the issue. **Spirit** won the Kentucky Derby at this trip in wire-to-wire fashion and he's been on the engine in his two comeback wins, most recently when benefitting from an inside speed bias Oct 2 at Santa Anita. Baffert has had him pressured by stablemate **Ax Man** in three consecutive works to get him ready for another pace battle (he's set a pressured pace in his last four starts). However, he's drawn

outside of **Knicks Go** and may have to be the one doing the pressing and that has not been his style. **Hot Rod Charlie** is refitted in small blinkers after racing a little erratically without them in two starts this summer. He's versatile enough to force the pace or track the other two and the paper race puts him 'right there'. He's the main threat to **Knicks Go**, but it's worth noting that only one tracking type has won this races in the 13 years since this race began moving between California and Kentucky (we're at Keeneland next fall). **Essential Quality** doesn't do very well on numbers, but he's only lost once and he had excuses when 4th to **Medina Spirit** in the Kentucky Derby. Balanced attackers have fared well over the last 13 years and **Quality** may be able to give Brad Cox the Exacta. **Spirit** figures to hang on gamely while **Art Collector** and **Max Player** are capable of tracking the pace and finishing evenly and both are eligible to impact the Superfecta.
CLOSERS: Fastest in the stretch in recent races at or near this distance have been: **Essential Quality** :23.5 - **Max Player** :24.5 - **Tripoli** :24.6

HORSE COMMENTS

Tripoli won the Pacific Classic at this trip here Aug 21, a race in which he was able to track the pace. He was farther behind **Medina Spirit** in the Awesome Again Oct 2 and gave way after being asked into the stretch. This group may be too far in front of him early for him to be effective.

Express Train is probably only entered because they don't have to ship him. He outfinished **Tripoli** Oct 2, but was no threat to the winner, and struggled in the Pacific Classic.

Hot Rod Charlie has been among the four best sophs all year. He gets French Cup blinkers (they are on the small side) after failing to maintain a straight course in his last two starts. He was first under the wire in both, can track the pace or set it as he did in the Pennsylvania Derby and should be well placed from the bell. He maintained a straight course and looked strong working in blinkers here on Saturday.

Essential Quality doesn't put up flashy numbers, but the 2020 2-yr Champion has only lost once to date and he had excuses when he finished 4th behind **Medina Spirit** and **Hot Rod Charlie** in the Kentucky Derby. He has been in steady training since winning the Travers Aug 28, a neck win over **Midnight Bourbon**, the horse that **Charlie** beat by two lengths in the Pa Derby (and caused to fall mid-stretch in the Haskell July 17). There is plenty of speed to set up his balanced attack. All he does is win and he's likely better than the Charting suggests.

Knicks Go is a dedicated frontrunner that is almost never under any early pressure. He's only lost twice since joining Brad Cox's barn (he also trains **Essential Quality**) and had excuses in both losses. The 5-yr dominates on paper, but will be trying to get this distance for the first time and may be pressured early by sophs **Medina Spirit** and **Hot Rod Charlie**. Those are his chinks.

Art Collector ran off four consecutive wins during 2020 and is out to run his 2021 winning streak to four after going wire-to-wire to win the Woodward Oct 2. He loses his regular rider to **Essential Quality**, but **Mike Smith** is an able replacement and a great judge of pace. He's capable of tracking the pace and his Pace Ratings suggest that he'll have to sit in the second flight to have any chance of extending his winning streak.

Stilleto Boy tracked **Medina Spirit** while saving ground (with the bias) in the Awesome Again and finished steadily to hold 2nd at 54/1. He figures to be an even longer price today and figures down the list.

Medina Spirit is still the Kentucky Derby winner and he's 2-for-2 on the comeback trail. His numbers improved when he was best in the Awesome Again Oct 2, a race in which he benefited from an inside speed bias. He's been working early in the a.m. with stablemate **Ax Man** and **Baffert** has had **Ax Man** press him from the outside in each drill, likely to mimic what might happen in today's race. He went much easier than **Ax Man** Oct 15 and Oct 22, but **Ax Man** appeared to be going easier last Friday. Bad works mean less than good works and our workout analyst gave that Oct 29 move a solid assessment. Your correspondent has watched the work twice on tape and was less impressed by that last work.

Max Player comes into this having won back-to-back 10-panel Graded Stakes, most recently when best in the Jockey Club Gold Cup Sept 4. He tracked the pacesetter in those wins and will likely take up position in the second flight again. However, he was sitting 2nd while relatively close in those wins and he may have to work really hard to stay in contact with the likes of **Knicks Go**. That could cost him late.

TRACK BIAS

Race tracks play differently every day due to weather, track maintenance, etc. Sometimes the track seems to favor no particular running style and no part of the track seems better than another. That's not always the case, though, and trip handicappers have long made their money by noting whether the track favored one type of running style or another and then following the horses that ran 'against the bias'. We divide track bias into two types on the main track. There are running style biases in which either horses with speed, we call them Front Runners in this table, or no early speed, Late Runners, have an advantage. There are also days when the rail is better than the outside and vice versa. These biases run from moderate to strong to dominant. We will code the biases as follows: 1= Moderate, 2= Strong, 3 = Dominant. The strong and dominant biases deserve the most attention. In turf racing, we report the position of the auxiliary rails, as the position of the temporary rails can affect which running styles win. Watch for our **new track profile by position of the rail**. It's in the Digest most everyday now.

HANDICAPPING FACTORS

(Column B on each race page contains the following numbers that refer to these factors.)

1. **FIRST TIME STARTER** - Horses with some racing experience, even when limited, often perform better than first-time starters even though the latter may have greater potential.
2. **LIVE HORSE** - It appears this horse is ready for a top performance.
3. **DISTANCE CAPABILITY** - This distance may present a problem for this horse.
4. **EQUIPMENT CHANGE** - Any equipment change may affect a horse's performance, and this horse is scheduled for a change today.
5. **TROUBLE PRONE** - Certain horses encounter trouble frequently, often being self-caused, such as not running straight, starting slowly, etc. This one seems to be that type.
- 6a. **WEIGHT** - This horse is carrying enough weight to cause a problem
- 6b. **WEIGHT** - This horse is carrying little or less weight. It may be an advantage.
7. **INSIDE POST POSITION** - This inside post position may cause a problem for this horse at this distance.
8. **OUTSIDE POST POSITION** - This outside post position may cause a problem for this horse at this distance.
9. **PACE** - The probable pace or speed in the early part of this race may not be suitable to the racing style of this horse.
- 10c. **HIGHER CLASS** - This horse is being tried at a higher level.
- 10d. **LOWER CLASS** - This horse is being tried at a lower level.
11. **FEMALE vs. MALE** - Since it usually takes a better-than-average female to beat an average male, there could be a problem here
12. **FOREIGN RACES** - Previous races for this horse were out of this country. It is difficult to appraise them.
13. **RELEASED FROM CLAIMING JAIL** - This horse could be dangerous. He is out of Jail and back to a lower level. (See Glossary under 'Jail').
14. **WORKOUTS** - Horsemen vary in their training methods and horses vary considerably in their requirements for conditioning, hence, while workouts give some indication of a horse's fitness, they can be greatly influenced by the training methods being employed. Therefore, reliance on the speed of workouts may be dangerous, as may be the case here.
15. **IN-THE-MONEY** - This horse appears to have all the elements suitable for an in-the-money performance.
- 15a. **IN-THE-MONEY** - This horse appears to have most of the elements suitable for an in-the-money performance.
16. **LONG LAYOFF or RECENCY** - Horse is coming off a layup of more than 90 days and the lack of racing is a potential negative.
17. **LEG WRAPS** - A horse racing with leg wraps may have some physical trouble or suspected weakness, and this horse has been wearing them.
18. **AGE** - The age of this horse is not consistent with that of his competition. A young horse against mature horses or a particularly old horse against younger horses may be at a disadvantage.
19. **IMPROVING** - This horse seems to be improving or should improve in this field.
20. **LONGSHOT** - Some indicators that are present when horses surprise with a good performance at high odds are noted.
21. **FITS RACE** - This horse seems to fit this race.
- 21c. **FITS RACE** - This horse seems to fit this race except for class.
- 21d. **FITS RACE** - This horse seems to fit this race except for the distance.
- 21r. **FITS RACE** - This horse seems to fit this race except for a lack of recency.
22. **CONDITIONS HORSE** - The conditions for eligibility are ideal for this horse.
23. **WORK READY** - Previous patterns and/or special circumstances make recent works very important here.
24. **SURFACE** - The type of surface for this race may not suit the horse.
25. **BETTING** - If the betting on this horse is heavier than expected contention is likely.
86. **VETO** - There is no justification for a win to be expected.

TODAY'S RACING DIGEST is designed to simplify the handicapper's job by evaluating past performances and relating them to today's race. To that end, the Digest provides the following on each page:

1. **Distance** – This is the distance of this particular race. If this was a turf race, we'd also note that here.
2. **Conditions** – We list the race conditions here. This particular race is a Starter Allowance.
3. **Track Profile** – This feature gives you an idea of what kind of running styles (e.g., frontrunners, pressers, etc.) have been winning at the race's distance. We list the number of races included in our study (22, in this case), then list the type of running style and the win-percentage. For example, Frontrunners ("F") have won 22.7% of the 22 races at this distance while Late-Runners ("R") have won just 4.5%. (F=frontrunner, P=pressers, M=midpackers, R=Late-Runners.)
4. **Race level** – The Digest assigns a number to each type or class of race. In this case, the race is a 130 on our class scale. This number allows you to compare races of different types to determine which races are stronger, the same class or weaker. Five points equals one class level.
5. **Race Conditions** – This is an abbreviation of the Conditions of the race.
6. **Purse** – This is how much money is up for grabs for this race. In most cases, the winner usually receives about 55 percent of the purse.
7. **AFTL** – The acronym stands for Average For The Level and are "par" times for the class. In other words, this class of animal should run these times over a normal surface. Compare the horse's times listed in their Data Lines (past performances) to the AFTL to see which horses have come close to running to par for this class.
8. **Favorites** – We list the percentages for winning favorites and favorites in the money under these class, age, surface, and distance conditions. Believe it or not, certain races produce more upsets than others and we try to give you the heads up by providing these stats.
9. **Horse** – We list the horses' names here, in post-position order. Also, sometimes you'll see a symbol after the name and this indicates the horse is having some type of equipment change. For instance, a "#" indicates the addition of blinkers, a "@" indicates blinkers are coming off and, FBH indicates a Foreign-bred horse. We also note betting entries by a letter ("A" or "B") before the name.
10. **Jockey** – This lists the jockey for each horse. When you see a dot (".") after the jockey's name, it means this jockey is replacing the jockey used from the previous race. An "x" after the jockey's names indicates he is an apprentice.
11. **Fire Number** – This is the horse's FIRE Number, a speed figure that takes into account each and every time recorded by the horse during the running of a race. The higher the number, the faster the horse.
12. **Weight & Change** – We list how much weight the horse is expected to carry here, as well as the difference between today's weight and the weight carried in its last race.
13. **Age/Sex** – How old is the horse, you say? We list that here, along with the horse's sex. (c=colt, g=gelding, r=ridgling, f=filly, m=mare)
14. **RRL** - Recent Race Level. This is the Race level of the horse's last race. Compare this number to the Race level in the Race Header to quickly determine whether the horse is up or down in class.
15. **RCL** - Recent Competitive Level. We list the Race level where the horse has recently been competitive. An "x" in this column indicates a horse hasn't been competitive at any level recently.
16. **CPR** - Comprehensive Performance Rating. Another Digest speed figure, this one is the oldest of the Digest's speed numbers. Once again, the higher the number, the faster the horse.
17. **Total** – This column is the total of RCL + CPR. It gives you a class and speed figure all in one.
18. **PER** - Performance Early in Race. We list the running styles for each horse. Just as we list in the Track Profile feature, F=frontrunner, P=presser, M=midpacker, R=late-runner
19. **Handicapping Factors** – Each horse usually receives certain Handicapping Factors (HF), which serve as a type of shorthand for us to communicate certain things about a horse to you. Most important in this column is our "push" factors. When we like a horse we'll use a 2 (love the horse), 15 (really like), 15a (like) or 20 (longshot).
20. **Equipment** – This is the equipment the horse has been or is scheduled to wear. B=blinkers, FW=front wraps, 4W= four wraps,
21. **Trouble** – If the horse was in trouble in any of its races, we list that here. A "1" indicates a horse's last race, a "2" a race back, etc. If the number is in parentheses (e.g., (2)), that means it was self-caused trouble.
22. **Off Track** – If the horse is proven over an off track, we list the Track Variant for that day here.
23. **Best Prev Sur Dis** - Best Previous CPR on the surface or distance. Pretty self explanatory. Whatever the distance or surface of today's race, we note the best CPR he's earned.
24. **Past Class** - Whatever the horse's highest proven Race level, it's listed here. This let's you know how classy a horse once was.
25. **Average RCL** – This is an average of the horse's recent Race levels where it has been competitive.
26. **Last CPR** – Simple, it's the CPR (remember, the CPR is a speed figure) from the horse's last race.
27. **Fractional Chart Order of Finish** – Lists the top finishers according to the Digest's popular Fractional Charting (a projected race using representative performances from each participant in today's race).
28. **Average Times** – The times listed on the ET (Expected Times) row are those expected from today's field based on previous performances (these are the best times at each call in the Fractional Charting). The AT (Average Times) are based on the times high class horses run at the distance/surface. The AFTL (Average For The Level) times are the "par times" for today's class of runners. In other words, they are the average times run by horses at today's particular class level.
29. **Analysis** – In this section, Digest handicappers provide their assessments of today's race, emphasizing pace and class and highlighting contenders and top plays.
30. **Closers** – Which horses finish fastest? We provide the top finishers here. This information is compiled from the Fractional Charting.
31. **Horse Comments** – Digest provide information about each horse and assess their chances.
32. **Horse name** – Simply put, this is the horse's name. Just so you know, a horse's name is limited to 18 characters and spaces...that's the rules.
33. **Trainer/Jockey** – The horse's trainer and today's rider are listed, along with their record (starts, wins, 2nds, 3rds) when teaming up over the past three months. In this instance, trainer Powell and jockey Rosario have had 10 starters together, with two wins, no 2nds and one 3rd the past three months.
34. **Age/Breeding** – The first number is the horse's age, followed by his sex. After the dash (-), the horse's sire is listed. In parentheses is the sire's offspring's win percentage on turf (T), synthetic (S), and in the mud (M). This is followed by the horse's dam, which is then followed by the dam's sire (a.k.a. - the mom's dad).
35. **Trainer Stats** – We list all the pertinent trainer stats in this section, such as the trainer's record from his last 15 starters (LAST 15) and how the trainer does with any moves the horse may be making today (i.e., going from dirt to turf (D/T), route to sprint (R/S), etc.).
36. **Notes** – What trouble has the horse encountered and when? The Digest lists this in abbreviated fashion.
37. **Course Records** – Shows how the horse has done sprinting or routing over today's surface. We also list the overall record on the surface whether it is sprints or routes.
38. **Works** – Recent workouts are shown here. The info includes the track, the date, the time of the work, the condition of the surface and how the work ranked relative to other times recorded that day.
39. **Last 10 FIRE** – These are the last 10 FIRE numbers earned for the horse, just for convenience.
40. **Track** – Indicates at what track the horse's race occurred.
41. **Date & Race** – Lists the date (MM/DD/YY) and the race number (after the dash) of the horse's race.
42. **Distance/Surface** – This is the distance, as well as the surface of the race. "T" indicates the race was a turf race. Sprints (under one mile) are noted in furlongs, whereas routes (one mile and over) are noted in miles, plus additional distance.
43. **Post Position & Key Race Winners** – The first number is the horse's post position for the race, followed by the total number of all the horses in the field. The numeral after the dash indicates how many horses returned from the particular race to win their next starts. Theoretically, the higher the number, the stronger that particular race.
44. **Weight** – This is the weight carried by the horse.
45. **Trainer/Jockey** – The horse's trainer and jockey for the particular race is noted here.
46. **Track Condition** – Was the track fast, muddy or sloppy? Was the turf firm or good? We note that in abbreviated form here. (FM = firm, FT = fast, GD = good, etc.)
47. **Track Bias** – A tremendous Digest feature. This column displays any bias that was in effect during the horse's race. We note the type of bias (O = outside, I = inside, F = speed bias, L = late-runner bias) as well as the strength of the bias on a scale of 1 to 3, with 1 being a mild bias and 3 being a dominant bias.
48. **Race Type** – Lists the type of race in abbreviated format.
49. **Race Conditions** – These are the conditions of the Race Type.
50. **RCL** – Race Competition Level. The level represents the strength of the race on the Digest's class scale. Comparing these numbers to one another allows the handicapper to see if the horse was moving up or down in class from race to race.
51. **CPR** – The number is one of the many Digest speed figures. This is the horse's CPR for each race.
52. **Finish Position & Beaten Lengths** – The first number is position the horse finished the race, followed by how many lengths he was beaten (or won by if the first number is a "1") crossing the wire.
53. **Odds** – The Digest lists both the horse's Morning Line odds and the Actual Odds at post time. This gives you an idea if the horse was bet (perhaps he was "live") or not ("dead on the board"). The "↑" indicates the horse was the post time favorite.
54. **Track Variant** – Sometimes surfaces can be slower or faster than normal for various reasons, usually due to weather or track maintenance. The variant adjusts the surface speed to account for these variances, and we list it here just because we believe in transparency.
55. **Position at Each Call & Beaten Lengths** – The first number is the horse's position at each call followed by his/her time at those calls (these are not the leaders times, they are this horse's particular times for the race). All times are adjusted to today's distance and surface, taking into account differences in track pars and variants (routes are adjusted to route and sprints to sprints, but not routes to sprints or vice versa). This allows for easy comparison among different distances and between tracks. In essence, the Digest does all the work so you don't have to.
56. **Last Fraction** – The final fraction the horse earned in the race. The final fraction has also been adjusted to account for differences in tracks, surfaces, pars and variants.
57. **Pace & Final Time Ratings** – Under the first column is the Pace Rating earned, a number which takes into account the speed the horse displayed through the first two calls. The second column lists the Final Time Rating, a speed figure that takes into account only the final time of the horse.
58. **Equipment** – All the equipment worn by the horse for its race is listed here. (L=Lasix, b=blinkers, 4=four wraps, F=front wraps, C=the horse was claimed out of the race).

- 29 ANALYSIS:** All six of these plot within less than three lengths at the wire, and they appear about that hard to separate. Looking for a price, we have some interest in **Warrens Stormalert** as a potential improver. He was ambitiously placed in the Snow Chief Stakes April 25, his first as a winner and first route, and, though he faded toward the rear, the effort figures OK with these. Low-profile connections should prompt some decent odds, so he's the HF 20 (longshot).
- 30 CLOSERS:** Fastest in the stretch in recent races at or near this distance have been: Green Card James :31.0 - Benezit :31.3 - Troubletimesthree :31.

HORSE COMMENTS

- 31** **Troubletimesthree** has usually run pretty well in five starts at this level, but was favored in three of them and finished farther back than usual April 15. He charts in the hunt, but he seems to have a bit to prove.
NOTES: Outrun April 15. Mild rally March 18. Mild wide rally Feb 19. Lacked racing room entering the stretch Jan 25.
- Warrens Stormalert** is bred to route, but the April 25 jump up to the Snow Chief Stakes for his first try with winners and initial route was pretty ambitious. He tracked a Lone 'F' leader and faded badly. Still, the effort gives him a shot on paper, so he can't be denied a chance on the drop.
NOTES: Wide around the first turn, chased and tired April 25.
